

## Summer Activities

Following feedback from this year's parent questionnaire, we are sending out summer activities so the children can extend their learning over the summer holidays. This summer we will be basing our activities on current events in Worcestershire. We have planned the activities to use resources available at home or cheap, fun experiences you can do as a family. If you need to borrow any resources please let us know.

### 1. Take part in the Great Waddle of Worcester:

The Great Waddle of Worcester is a trail is a Wild in Art event brought to Worcester by St Richard's Hospice. The trail is available Monday 22nd July - Sunday, 15th September. The great big penguin sculptures will be positioned within one mile radius of Worcester city centre and the chicks will be positioned throughout Crown Gate Shopping Centre. The trail is approximately 5 miles and will take around 2-3 hours to complete, following the trail map route with time to take photos. Locations will be found on trail maps or on the trail app which will be downloadable from the Google Play Store and the Apple App Store nearer the time. Trail maps will be available, for £1, from various outlets across Worcester city centre from 23rd July 2024.

Can the children complete the trail? How many penguin sculptures did they see? Which penguin was their favourite? Who designed their favourite penguin? If older, how many small penguins did they see? How many big penguins did they see? Can they say how many penguin altogether?



### 2. Create your own penguin structure:

Can the children make their own penguin structure using blocks, Lego, recyclable materials etc. The children can use anything you have already at home.

### 3. Draw your own penguin:

Can the children draw their own penguin? Can they name the colours they have used? If older can they copy their name?
