## Session Times

The group opens five days a week during school term times (38 weeks a year). Children may attend for a variety of session's dependant on their age.

Early Years Educational Funding is available for children (15 hours per week dependant on spaces). The funding covers 38 weeks per year split over three terms. We are in receipt of nursery education funding for two, three and four year olds; where funding is not received, then fees apply.

Free places are provided as flexibly as possible, taking into account the needs of the parents and the children. We cater for children aged 2 years to school age.

Pre-school children (children going to school the following school year) can attend any sessions although dedicated sessions are on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

- 3 free hours x 5 days per week (mornings Monday - Friday) 9.00 – 12.00
- 3 free hours x 5 days per week (afternoons Monday - Friday) 12.00 – 3.00

All sessions are available for children the term after they turn 3 years of age, younger children can attend Monday, Wednesday and Friday. (We can cater for younger children on a Tuesday and Thursday, please ask for details).

YOU CAN CHOOSE ANY SESSION MORNING AND / OR AFTERNOON

**You do not have to arrive at 9.00 or finish at 3.00, the start time and finish time are up to you but the sessions are 3 hours in total.**

## Fees

Any unfunded hours are charged as follows:-

- £4.50 per hour (Qualifying period - the term after the child turns three year of age).
- £5.00 per hour for two year olds (a different rate due to higher staff ratio's).

Following Worcestershire County Council guidelines, there will be at least one child exempt from paying the enrichment fee per term. This child will remain anonymous. This will be determined by the following rules;

1. EYPP (Early Years Pupil Premium) - A child is on EYPP or receiving 2 year old funding.
2. If there is more than 1 child on EYPP or receiving 2 year old funding, the name will be drawn from a hat.
3. If there are no children on EYPP or receiving 2 year old funding, all the children's names will be put in a hat and drawn to see what child will receive the exemption.

The enrichment fees allow us to give the children different experiences to learn from, and give us the opportunity to bring outside teachers in.

There is an additional charge whenever a child is collected outside agreed times without our prior arrangement or phone call (currently £10.00).

Full fees are payable during holiday and sickness absences.

Fees are payable by the due date stated on the bill, usually the week after the bill is sent.

Interest will be charged on unpaid fees outstanding for more than one month at the rate of 10% p.a. **and we may withdraw your child's place from nursery until payment is received.**

A terms notice needs to be given to withdraw a child from the Nursery or reduce the number of sessions to be attended and in default fees will be payable in lieu of notice. If you change setting during the term the nursery has the right to keep the funding provided by the government, exceptions do apply, please ask for details.

When your child qualifies for funding you will need to fill in a Parent Declaration Form and agree to the Avoncroft Nursery Flexible Funding and Local agreement.
